We have many popular events through the year, from Wassail to Craft Fairs. Look out on our website or social media for information about these.

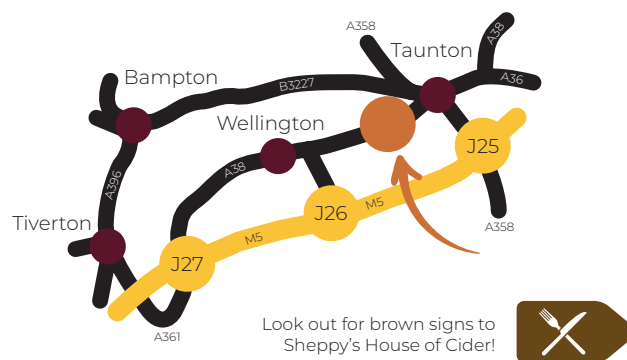


HOW TO FIND US
